Any information contained within this Manual should be treated as Top Secret and should not be shared with any person or persons outside of Agency employment.

Under Department regulations and established law, the Bureau of Security has the sole authority to determine whether your security clearance should be suspended on the basis of "all facts available upon receipt of the initial derogatory information." The standard to be applied is to determine whether it is "in the interests of national security" to continue your security status or to suspend it.

If at any point before proceeding with this document, you wish to discontinue the process, please bring this manual, along with all supplies issued to you, to your nearest DFTPAR base or office for debriefing.

LEAVING IT ALL BEHIND: A NEW LIFE WITH DFTPAR



STEP ONE:

Once you have been inducted into DFTPAR, there will be little to no connection to the life you lived before that moment. In order to effectively execute your duties you will, in most cases, be stripped of any other ranks or titles you hold, your name removed from all public facing websites, and moved to a different region of the country or world. This is all done to better insulate you, and your loved ones, from the very real impact this work can have on a person.

STEP TWO:

After you have been certified with preliminary security clearance, Proceed to the Agent/Research section the DFTPAR website, and commence your first job.



STEP THREE:

After completion, you can apply for your DFTPAR Identification card which is your passport to your new life.

THREAT ASSESSMENT SYSTEM: T.A.S.

T.A.S. or Threat Assessment System is the crown jewel of our DFTPAR system of being prepared for each mission as best is possible. To keep our soldiers and scientists, and the public, safe; that is our highest priority.

This system was designed via trial and error over the course of several decades; honing it down into the concise and effective system of pre-mission preparedness.

A mission objective can be to retrieve an object or neutralize a biological threat. Each of those would be classed according to the danger it poses to our agents and those who might be affected by it.

Geographically speaking, each place that an agent can be deployed to is designated, again, by the danger exposure to the region can entail.
